Who is Bonnyville Victim Services ?

Bonnyville Victim Services is a non-profit organization. We are funded by the Solicitor General of Alberta, and a member of the Alberta Police Based Victim Services Association.

Our Board of Directors, is a Governance Board which consists of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer and up to 7 directors.

This board is responsible for setting the mission, vision and tone for the organization.

The day to day management of the program is the responsibility of the Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator. The time and energy of the board should be spent on fundraising, strategic planning and advocacy for the program.

► Requirements for becoming a member of the Board Of Directors

1. Any person residing in Alberta and being the full age of 18 years may become a member by filling out the appropriate applications, providing a Criminal Record check, signing an "Oath of Confidentiality" and "Code of Ethical Conduct".
2. Must demonstrate ethical and professional conduct to maintain the integrity of the program.
3. Regular attendance of monthly supper meetings.
4. Participation in training opportunities that support increased knowledge of program administration is encouraged. Training opportunities include the SGPS Board Training. Any expenses are paid by the unit.
5. Willing to volunteer at Victim Services fundraisers and other events.

6. Respond to any correspondence in a timely manner.
7. Good communication and decision making skills.
